

Beyond Fatalism: Resistance and Resilience to Climate Change



Tim DeChristopher is a climate change activist and the co-founder of the environmental group Peaceful Uprising and the Climate Disobedience Center. As a graduate of the Harvard Divinity School, Tim's work combines environmental activism and religious thought. His career as an activist was launched by an act of civil disobedience in 2008, when he disrupted an oil and gas land auction to protect land parcels around Utah's Arches and Canyonlands National Parks. His efforts led to the protection of the land and his imprisonment for 21 months.
