Revolving around blackmail and political corruption, the action, set in London in 1895, takes place over the course of twenty-four hours, and touches on themes of public and private honor that are as resonant today as they were when Wilde first penned them.

First performed in 1895, it is often considered Wilde's dramatic masterpiece. "Sooner or later," Wilde notes, "we shall all have to pay for what we do."
