To provide an ideal environment with one-on-one attention, participation is limited to approximately 80 campers per week, and registration is on a first come, first serve basis.

## Site and Facilities

## Registration

Registration will open on **April 15, 2024** and will be done on a first come first serve basis. A \$50 non-refundable deposit per child is required for each week before the registration form will be processed. The remaining balance is due the Wednesday **BEFORE** your child is to arrive at camp.

**If the balance is not paid by that Wednesday, a \$10 late fee will be applied to your account.**

Registrations cannot be processed without completing your child's medical information.

**Strictly enforced.**

## Groups

Campers are divided into groups according to age. We will do our best to accommodate requests to place children in certain groups, but due to NYS camper to counselor ratio guidelines, we may not be able to accommodate every request.



## Weeks Provided

Niagara University's Summer Youth Camp will run from **July 1 to August 9**. Children may register for one week or for all six weeks. Please see the enclosed registration form to enroll.

## Camp Fees

- Week 1: \$135 per week (3 day week)
- Weeks 2–6: \$225 per week
- \$50 non-refundable deposit is required for each week a child is registered.

## 1. Family Discount

Parents who sign up two or more children will be given a \$10 discount off the cost of their second child (and each child thereafter) from the immediate family. This discount will be applied to each week the subsequent children are registered.

## 2. Multi-Week Discount

If your child is signed up for 5 or more of the weeks, you will be given a \$10 discount off each week.

**Only one discount per camper.**

## Refunds and Cancellations

The \$50 camp deposit is non-refundable. Refunds will only be given for medical reasons. Refunds may be subject to a \$25 administrative fee. A written request with a physician's letter of explanation is necessary to process the refund. In case of illness or injury during camp week, prorated credits will be awarded toward another camp week. Refunds or credits will be rewarded only if the camper(s) misses three or more days in one week due to illness. There will be a \$25 charge for all refunds or checks returned due to insufficient funds.

## Drop Off and Pick Up

Dropping children off with our friendly, qualified staff when the camp begins and again upon departure will require your signature.

Children will not be permitted to be dropped off before 8:45 a.m. and must be picked up between 3:30 and 3:45 p.m.

If children arrive before, or are not picked up by the times stated above, an **extended care service fee** will be charged. This fee will be required to be paid by closing on Friday of each week. **Times are strictly enforced.**

## Lunch

Lunch can be purchased at the campus dining hall for \$6 per day. The lunches are catered, and offer a variety of foods such as pizza, hamburgers, hotdogs, salads, fruit, and vegetables.

## Extended Care Fees

For parents who need additional child care services outside the camp's operational hours, an extended childcare service will be provided.

The extended care service will be available from 7:30–8:44 a.m. for \$5 per day and from 3:46–5:30 p.m. for \$5 per day. There is also a flat rate fee which allows you to use extended care as much as you need for \$40 per week. If you choose this option it must be paid by 5:30 p.m. on Monday of each week.

**NOTE:** Campers picked up after 5:30 p.m. will be charged an additional \$10.

## Code of Conduct

All campers are expected to treat others with dignity and respect and abide by camp rules. If campers are unable to adhere to camp rules and policies they may be asked to leave camp.
